





Gary Baldwin

Commenced in beverage industry making cider in Pakenham, then moved to winemaking in the Hunter Valley, after studying at CSU. Next move was to the Australian Wine Research Institute, Adelaide, as Manager of extension services. For the past eleven years, a consulting winemaker, initially with Oenotec and then with Wine Network Australia. Judged at Brisbane, Hobart, Perth as well as Melbourne and in many regional and specialist wine shows.

Jeff Clarke

Has been chief winemaker at Montana Wines Limited, New Zealand's leading wine producer since 1993. In 1999 was named White Winemaker of the Year at the International Wine Challenge in London. Has a degree in oenology from the internationally recognized winemaking facility at Roseworthy College in the Barossa Valley. Was chief winemaker at Tisdall/Mount Helen for 10 years before moving to Montana Wines, where he remains as chief winemaker.

Andrew Corrigan MW

Andrew originally qualified as a Civil Engineer and is still involved in property and construction in Brisbane. He teaches wine appreciation courses, writes for Brisbane News, Winestate and other newspapers and has a weekly program called "Tabletalk" on ABC radio. He consults to wine retailers and restaurants. He became a Mate of Wine in 1997.

John Ellis

Proprietor and Winemaker of the Hanging Rock Winery. Judge at Melbourne Show since 1980. Current Chairman Swan Hill; Judge Rutherglen. Previous appointments: Sydney, Canberra, Cairns (Chair) Barossa, Mudgee (Chair), Seymour, Ballarat (Chair) and Griffith.

Mike Farmilo

Managing Director and principal winemaker at Boar's Rock, a contract processing and winemaking facility established in 1998 at McLaren Vale. Retired from Southcorp in 1997 after 13 years with Wynns - Seaview - Southcorp. The last six years as Group Res winemaker. Chairman of Riverland Wine Show and also judges at Rutherglen and Adelaide Hyatt Awards.

John Hanley

Has been judging wine since early 1970's. He has participated in tastings in most Australian states and National Shows in New Zealand, United Kingdom and the United States of America. A position he has held for the past 10 years. He has judged in excess of 110 Wine Shows.

Ray Healey

Has judged in Sydney and Singleton. Is currently involved in judging in Melbourne, Hobart, Brisbane, Rutherglen, Maitland and Mudgee.

Justin Howard-Sneyd

Buyer for UK supermarket chains Sainsburys. Helped to run the International Wine Challenge in London 1991 - 1995. Passed the Master of Wine exam in 1999. This is his first experience of Australian Wine judging.

Dr Tony Jordon

Currently head of winemaking at Chandon Estates with responsibilities in Australia, Europe, Argentina, South Africa & Brazil. Formerly Managing Director of Wirra Wirra vineyards and Managing Director / winemaker Domaine Chandon in the Yarra Valley. Over the last 20 years has judged at all National Wine Shows as well as many regional and also in United Kingdom & New Zealand. Recently invited to judge at South Africa varietal Wine show.

Chris Killeen

Chris is manager and a sixth generation winemaker of his family owned winery of Stanton and Killeen Wines at Rutherglen in North East Victoria. He has been part of the Australian wine industry since the early seventies and has previously judged at a number of Australian Wine shows including Griffith, Swan Hill, Forbes and the Victorian Wines Show.

Sally McGill

Sally entered the Wine Trade in London in the late 1980's. In 1989 completed a Diploma of Wine & Spirit Education Trust and moved to Italy to further her knowledge of International wine styles and markets, working in PR, Wine Education and Sales. Is currently at Red + White previously known as FD & CWine as Imports Manager. Associate Judge at both Melbourne and Rutherglen Wine Shows becoming a full member of the Melbourne and Rutherglen Judging Panels in 1999. Is a 2000 Judge at the inaugural Red Hill Cool Climate Wine Show.

Chris Pfeiffer

Worked for Lindemans Wines from 1974 - 1984 in various locations in Australia gaining experience in all aspects of winemaking. Is currently Chairman of Judges at both the Rutherglen Wine show and the Griffith Wine Show. He also judges at the Royal Hobart Wine Show and has judged at the Royal Melbourne Wine Show since 1985 and has judged at the National Wine Show in Canberra, the Victorian Wine Show and the Swan Hill Wine Show. Chris is a foundation member of the Australian Society of Wine Educators, is currently the Chairman of the Victorian Wine Industry Association and represents Victoria as an affiliate member of the Winemakers Federation of Australia.

Randall Pollard

Randall has judged in Melbourne, Griffith and the Victorian Wines Show over the last 10 years. He is proprietor of Randall the Wine Merchant retail store and wine writer for the Geelong Independent.

Ben Riggs

Born 1964. 19 vintages in Australia, 3 in France, 2 in Italy, 2 in Greece, 1 in the United States of America. Has judged McLaren Vale Wine Show and the Melbourne Wine Show. Completed advanced wine assessment course AWR1.

Tony Royal

National & Regional Wine Show judging experience over past 7 years. 17 years winemaking experience. Currently General Manager, Sequin Moreau Australasia. Proprietor and winemaker Armstrong Vineyards.

NOTES ON WINE JUDGING

Exhibits in all Australian Wine Shows are judged on a comparative basis, i.e. all the entries are judged at the same time. The other method used in Varietal classes in Adelaide is the International system where the wines are judged and pointed individually.

Exhibits are judged on a point score with a maximum of 20 points.

On the judging sheets this is divided into:

1. 3 points for colour and condition, usually wines with poor colour are rejected for defects on both nose and palate.
2. 2.7 points for nose.
3. 3. 10 points for palate: a wine with an excellent nose may fall down on the palate due to excessive acidity or tannin defects. Conversely, some wines with only a fair nose may have excellent balance on the palate.

Medals are awarded for the following points:

- 18.5 - 20 – Gold Medal
17.0 - 18.4 – Silver Medal
15.5 - 16.9 – Bronze Medal

All exhibits are judged on the blind. Judges do not handle the bottles.

In Melbourne, the judges are arranged into four groups, each of three judges, with a Chairman of Judges who arranges the groups of judges, divides the classes to be judged between four groups, gives guidance and occasionally resolves disagreements.

Each class is set up and poured by associate judges, who have a set of glasses with the judges.

The judge assess the wines, point them and then collaborate on the medals awarded. The points listed in the results section represent the total of the three judges assessments.

Judges are generally selected from those who work in or are connected with the wine industry. Potential judges are recommended to the Royal Agricultural Society of Victoria Limited and are given experience as associate judges. New judges are selected from the best performers.

The following definitions of the various wine types are offered for the guidance of exhibitors.

Varietal wines should comprise at least 80% of the specified variety for 1997 and earlier vintages and 85% of the specified variety for later vintages.

DRY WHITE TABLE WINES

Should be a brilliant condition, pale to medium straw in colour, preferably with a slight green tinge. Light to full bodied, medium to high acidity with a fresh bouquet, clean after taste, no lingering sweetness. In the wooded classes, the oak should be in harmony with the vinosity of the wine. Alcoholic strength should be between 8% and 14% alcohol.

MEDIUM DRY WHITE WINE

Specification similar to Dry White Table wine but with some sweetness not exceeding 1 degree baume.

SWEET WHITE TABLE WINE

Should be in a brilliant condition, straw to light golden colour, medium to full bodied with a bouquet which is aromatic or complete and distinctly sweet in flavour. Its alcoholic strength should not exceed 14% by volume and it should not show excessive sulphur dioxide. Baume should not exceed 1 degree.

ROSE

A still, light and tart table wine with a slight tannin finish and a fresh fruit flavour but without Muscat character. Colour pink, but many have a trace of apricot or amber tint. Alcoholic strength should be between 8% and 14% by volume.

LIGHT BODIED DRY RED

Colour, light to medium red. A blue or purple tint may be present. Aroma and bouquet - varietal aroma may occur in varying degrees. It should be fresh and fruity and in harmony with the body and flavour of the wine. Palate - soft and light without being thin and rounded in the mid palate. Finish clear and crisp with soft astringency. The alcoholic strength should be between 8% and 12% by volume.

DRY RED

Colour medium to deep red. According to age, a blue or purple tint may be present in a young wine or a light brown edge may be present in an aged wine. Aroma and bouquet - varietal aroma may occur in varying degrees. It should be

fruity and in harmony with the body and flavour of the wine. The bouquet may show evidence of maturation in oak vessels and in older wines bottle age. Palate soft rounded and generous in mid palate. Body medium is full in balance with the acidity. Finish clean with tannin from maturation in wood but this should no predominate. The alcoholic strength should be between 8% and 14.5%.

SWEET WHITE DESSERT

Golden to dark brown in colour depending on age. Must not show Muscat character but have fruity and aromatic bouquet. It must be full bodied, soft and luscious. Strength not to exceed 20/5% alcohol by volume.

MUSCAT

Colour golden to red. Distinct bouquet and palate. Full bodied and soft and luscious. Strength not to exceed alcohol by volume.

RUBY RED

Colour golden to dark red. Bouquet and palate full and fruity. Excessive astringency is not acceptable. Strength not to exceed 20.5% alcohol by volume.

TAWNY PORT

Colour pale red with distinct amber tinge. Bouquet fruit and aromatic, palate full and soft with distinct dryness on the finish. Some flavour of oak tannin from the maturing wood is desirable. A lingering sweetness on the after palate is undesirable. Strength not to exceed 20.5% alcohol by volume.

VINTAGE PORT

Colour deep ruby to light ruby, possibly with slight amber tint, depending on age. Bouquet fruit and characteristic of bottle aged vintage port. Should not show wood character. Flavour full and soft with firm astringent finish and no lingering sweetness. Strength not to exceed 20.5% alcohol by volume.

SHERRY, Pale, Dry, Fino

Colour straw to pale golden. Bouquet characteristic of flor sherry. Flavour light and dry without excessive acidity or astringency, but some oak character. Finish dry, aromatic with distinct 'nutty' after taste of sherry. Strength not to exceed 20.5% by volume.

SHERRY, Amontillado

Colour golden to light amber. Bouquet showing more age than Fino sherry. Palate fuller and softer than Fino with some oak discrepancy showing through. Finish dry and aromatic with characteristic, 'nutty' after taste of sherry. Strength not to exceed 20.5% by volume.

SHERRY, Oloroso

Colour amber to brown. Bouquet showing both oak and sherry character. Palate soft and round but with a dry finish. Strength not to exceed 20.5% alcohol by volume.

SPARKLING WHITE WINE

Colour should be pale to light straw. Should have good acidity and not be too light in body. Bouquet should be fresh without particular varietal character and should indicate some years in the bottle. The wine should be fairly dry but show no astringent finish. Bubbles should be fine and persistent.

SPARKLING RED WINE

Colour should be light to medium ruby. Older wines may show a trace of amber but not more than a trace. Bouquet fruity but should show bottle age. Fairly pronounced acidity. Full flavour and body, some sweetness but with a dry finish. May show slight oak character. Bubbles should be fine and persistent.

TWO YEAR OLD BRANDY

Entries in this class should be representative of popular commercial brandies, but should avoid fruitiness. The brandy should be well balanced distillate of wine made from neutral grape varieties. It should avoid excessive heads or tails and should not show varietal character (e.g. Muscat). It should be smooth but without evident sweetness. A clear balance bouquet is essential. Colour light amber.

OLD BRANDY

Colour may be somewhat darker than in the young brandy class. Well matured oak should be distinguishable on both bouquet and flavour. Bouquet should be clean and somewhat ethereal but well balanced showing no particular constituent to excess. Flavour should be full smooth and aromatic. Finish aromatic without trace of fusel oil. No varietal character or fruitiness should be evident. Some slight sweetness is acceptable.

INDEX TO COMPETITION CLASSES

1. 2000 VINTAGE SECTION

CLASS 11 - DRY WHITE TABLE WINE - Riesling.

CLASS 12 - DRY WHITE TABLE WINE from highly aromatic floral varieties (other than Riesling) and blends of these varieties.
The variety(ies) to be specified on the entry form. Examples: Traminer, Frontignac, Traminer-Riesling.

CLASS 13 - DRY WHITE TABLE WINE - Chardonnay.

CLASS 14 - DRY WHITE TABLE WINE - Semillon.

CLASS 15 - DRY WHITE TABLE WINE - Sauvignon Blanc.

CLASS 16 - DRY WHITE TABLE WINE - for blends and varieties ineligible for Classes 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15. The variety(ies) to be specified on the entry form. Examples: Chenin Blanc, Verdelho, Marsanne.

CLASS 17 - MEDIUM WHITE TABLE WINE - not exceeding one (1) degree Baume.

CLASS 18 - SWEET WHITE TABLE WINE - not less than one (1) degree Baume.

2. 1999 VINTAGE SECTION

CLASS 19 - DRY RED - Cabernet Sauvignon.

CLASS 20 - DRY RED - Shiraz.

CLASS 21 - DRY RED - Pinot Noir.

CLASS 22 - DRY RED - Merlot.

CLASS 23 - DRY RED - not eligible for Classes 19, 20, 21 and 22. The variety(ies) to be specified on the entry form.

N.B. Entries in Classes 19, 20, 21, 22 and 23 are eligible for the Jimmy Watson Memorial Trophy Award.

FORTIFIED WINE

CLASS 24 - SWEET WHITE, DESSERT.

CLASS 25 - SWEET RED, DESSERT.

CLASS 26 - VINTAGE PORT.

CLASS 27 - MUSCAT.

3. VICTORIAN WINE SECTION

N.B. Wines in Classes 30 to 31 must be in bottles and ready for consumption at time of entry.

2000 VINTAGE

CLASS 28 - DRY WHITE TABLE WINE.

1999 VINTAGE

CLASS 29 - DRY RED TABLE WINE.

1999 VINTAGE AND OLDER

CLASS 30 - DRY WHITE TABLE WINE.

1998 VINTAGE AND OLDER

CLASS 31 - DRY RED TABLE WINE.

4. OPEN SECTION

N.B. Wines in Classes 32 to 51 must be in bottles and ready for consumption at time of entry.

2000 VINTAGE AND OLDER

CLASS 32 - ROSE.

1999 VINTAGE AND OLDER

CLASS 33 - DRY WHITE TABLE WINE from highly aromatic, floral varieties (such as Traminer, Frontignan, Riesling, Traminer Riesling) and blends of these varieties. The variety(ies) to be specified on the entry form.

CLASS 34 - DRY WHITE TABLE WINE - Chardonnay.

CLASS 35 - DRY WHITE TABLE WINE - Semillon.

CLASS 36 - DRY WHITE TABLE WINE - Sauvignon Blanc.

CLASS 37 - DRY WHITE TABLE WINE - for blends and varieties ineligible for classes 33, 34, 35 and 36 (such as Marsanne, Verdelho). Variety(ies) to be specified on the entry form.

CLASS 38 - MEDIUM DRY WHITE TABLE WINE, not exceeding (1) one degree Baume.

CLASS 39 - SWEET WHITE TABLE WINE, not less than (1) one degree Baume.

CLASS 40 - RED WINE, light style.

1998 VINTAGE

CLASS 41 - DRY RED - Cabernet Sauvignon.

CLASS 42 - DRY RED - Shiraz.

CLASS 43 - DRY RED - Pinot Noir.**CLASS 44** - DRY RED - Merlot.**CLASS 45** - DRY RED, not eligible for Classes 41, 42, 43 and 44. The variety(ies) to be specified on the entry form.**1997 VINTAGE AND OLDER****CLASS 46** - DRY RED, Cabernet Sauvignon.**CLASS 47** - DRY RED, Shiraz.**CLASS 48** - DRY RED, Pinot Noir.**CLASS 49** - DRY RED, not eligible for Classes 46, 47 and 48. The variety(ies) to be specified on the entry form.**AGED WINES - 1995 VINTAGE AND OLDER****CLASS 50** - DRY RED WINE. The variety(ies) to be specified on the entry form.**CLASS 51** - DRY WHITE WINE. The variety(ies) to be specified on the entry form.**FORTIFIED WINES - ANY VINTAGE****CLASS 52** - SHERRY - Pale, Dry, Fino.**CLASS 53** - SHERRY - Amontillado.**CLASS 54** - SHERRY - Oloroso.**CLASS 55** - SWEET WHITE DESSERT.**CLASS 56** - MUSCAT.**CLASS 57** - TAWNY PORT, not exceeding six (6) degrees Baume.**CLASS 58** - LIQUEUR PORT, exceeding six (6) degrees Baume.**CLASS 59** - VINTAGE PORT.**5. COMMERCIAL SECTION**

N.B. Wines in this Section must be in bottles and ready for consumption at time of entry.

Wines entered in Classes 60 to 72 must come from a commercial bottling run.

ANY VINTAGE**CLASS 60** - DRY WHITE TABLE WINE from highly aromatic, floral varieties (such as Traminer, Frontignan, Riesling, Traminer-Riesling) and blends of these varieties. The variety(ies) to be specified on the entry form.**CLASS 61** - DRY WHITE TABLE WINE - Chardonnay.**CLASS 62** - DRY WHITE TABLE WINE - Semillon.**CLASS 63** - DRY WHITE TABLE WINE - for blends and varieties ineligible for Classes 60, 61 and 62. The variety(ies) to be specified on the entry form.**CLASS 64** - MEDIUM DRY WHITE TABLE WINE, not exceeding one (1) degree Baume.**CLASS 65** - SPARKLING WHITE WINE, naturally fermented, in tank or bottle.**CLASS 66** - DRY RED - Cabernet Sauvignon.**CLASS 67** - DRY RED - Shiraz.**CLASS 68** - DRY RED - for blends and varieties ineligible for Classes 66 and 67. The variety(ies) to be specified on the entry form.**FORTIFIED WINES ANY VINTAGE**

Quantity 4,500 litres (Each entry consists of three (3) bottles).

CLASS 69 - DESSERT WHITE.**CLASS 70** - MUSCAT.**CLASS 71** - TAWNY PORT, not exceeding six (6) degrees Baume.**CLASS 72** - LIQUEUR PORT, exceeding six (6) degrees Baume.**6. SPARKLING WINE SECTION****CLASS 73** - SPARKLING WHITE WINE - 1998 Vintage and younger or younger than 24 months (average age) for NV wines.**CLASS 74** - SPARKLING WHITE WINE - 1997 Vintage and older or older than 24 months (average age) for NV wines.**CLASS 75** - SPARKLING ROSE WINE, naturally fermented in bottle, aged on lees for not less than 6 months.**CLASS 76** - SPARKLING RED WINE, naturally fermented in bottle, aged on lees for not less than 6 months.**7. BRANDY SECTION**

All Brandy exhibits are to be broken down by the Exhibitor to an alcohol by volume of not less than 37% and not more than 44%. Such strength to be notified on entry form and will appear on the bottle label.

"Breaking down" refers to samples only and due allowance must be made for the possibility of higher strengths in the bulk quantities.

CLASS 77 - BRANDY, two years and not exceeding five years. Exhibits to be composed wholly of Brandy of not greater age than five years at the closing date of entries. **Quantity 2,600 litres of alcohol.****CLASS 78** - BRANDY, open, five years and older. **Quantity 1,300 litres of alcohol.**
